

Class40 Newsflash - Roma per Due, 23rd April 2010

Victory for Thierry Bouchard and Oliver Krauss in the Roma per Due!

Thierry Bouchard and Oliver Krauss, racing on Mistral Loisirs – Pôle Santé Elior, were top Class40 in the 17th edition of the Roma per Due. Two other Class40s took part in the double-handed 530 mile race from Rome to the Lipari Islands and back: Adriatech (David Consorte) and Great Circle (Gérald Bibot).



There was some wind and glorious sunshine for Class40's first showing in the Roma per Due. The weather was perfect, and provided competitors with a tactical and technical race, albeit fairly light.

« We had breeze all night, and changed sails non-stop to get the most out of the dropping breeze. This time round, Oliver and I got our sleep management right. The boat is really well set up. We had a superb time, both because of the course, and the welcome we were given. »
